**PR60:** This unit is gas-fired. A 30 lb. tank will do approximately 15 hours of cooking at a temperature of 300-325 degrees.

**BBQ42:** Use approximately 25-30 lbs. of charcoal to cook 40 lbs. of chicken for first rack. If you wish to continue to a second rack, add approximately 10-15 lbs. of charcoal. For other cuts of meat, grilling, smoking, etc., put in your desired amount of charcoal.
