Use approximately 25-30 lbs. of charcoal to cook 40 lbs. of chicken for first rack. If you wish to continue to a second rack, add approximately 10-15 lbs. For other cuts of meat, grilling, smoking, etc., put in your desired amount.

Use approximately 60 lbs. of charcoal to cook a 125 lb. pig (live weight), 100 lbs. (dressed) at a temperature of 300 degrees. Cook approximately 8-10 hours or until shoulder meat reaches 180 degrees.
